



Creating Tones

In OAS-instruments the most modern 32-bit-DSP components are used, which facilitates not only sampling but also algorithmically produce tones. Because of this OAS instruments offer unlimited sound possibilities and the software both in sound and function can be upgraded at any time.



With additional software, e.g. Cubasis, allow scores music to be printed from the recordings.



OAS-instruments combine the visual world (using monitor/ printer/ laser) with the world of music. If you want to print scores, add a sound track to videos or slides, or put music to moving pictures on a video projector, now it's possible.



Memory revolution

Wersi's OAS piano sound alone represents 30 MB of information. This is stored on the harddrive. 10 years ago this would have been enough memory for 60 complete organs. Then it's obvious that the sound revolution is, among other things, a "memory" revolution. With up to 512 MB RAM and up to 40 gigabytes of harddisk memory it opens unlimited possibilities for sound and function. (e.g. also hard disk recording).



Extendibility

OAS instruments are one of the first instruments which through the use of software can be upgraded in sound and function. This means that endless new sounds, rhythms, styles and sound waves can be loaded. It also means that, via the software, one can create completely new characteristics and functions.

New software, new instrument: Exactly as one would take it from a computer.

Compatibility

Open Art Instruments are compatible with today's computer and internet world. (Windows 98*). Through the MIDI GM/XG and interfaces, such as USB or COM-Ports, you can use third party software (e.g. AKAI*). You can also connect directly with the popular data carriers (CD, CD-ROM, Floppy) to periphal devices (e.g. Printer, Internet) and software (e.g. Cubase*) respectively.



System Control

The different sound and effect groups are controlled through an integrated computer with Windows 98*. The screen is a Touch Screen and the Mouse and Keyboard can be linked up together. In the normal operation, the computer steps into the background and makes handling the instruments simple and comfortable. Full settings allow saving and reaccess at the touch of a button.





Dynamic layers enable the dynamic play with up to four different sounds (kombi sounds) per button. Simultaneaously, so that for example with heavier touch, the piano tones become louder.

OAS instruments offer hundreds of sounds, which can be recorded sound waves or algorithmically produce Sample Sounds. In addition, there are organ tones, which are controlled by stops. Every one of these sounds, is a work of art and an instrument in itself. In playing together with the left hand, (up to three voices simultaneously) and right hand (up to four voices simultaneously) as well as the arranged accompaniments (unlimited), up to 144 notes of various instruments can be played/produced simultaneously.








Wersi is also proud to present its new system "Real Drums", in which the rhythm is no longer created by a machine, but rather as a sound wave. With the "Real Drums" a live drummer plays the various rhythms, including variations, fills and breaks. As a result, the rhythms are more lifelike and the sounds more authentic.
